

# Visa process and costs involved



## NARIC

Register an account with UK NARIC.

As part of this process, you will require your educational certificate(s), transcript(s) and a Medium of Instruction Letter(MOL)\*.

**Cost:** About R1400 (subject to change)

## TB Test

Get tested at your nearest approved clinic.

**Cost:** R2500 (subject to change)

## CoS

Your CoS will only be issued once you have submitted your TB Test results & NARIC. Once you have received your Cos, you can apply for your Visa

**Cost:** No cost



## Visa Application

The earliest you can apply for a visa is 3 months before you're due to start work in the UK. The date you can start is listed on your certificate of sponsorship.

You should get a decision on your visa within 3 weeks when you apply from outside the UK.  
**Cost:** £610 for the main applicant & £610 per dependant

## Healthcare Surcharge

You would pay the Healthcare Surcharge as part of your Visa Application.

**Cost:** £1200.00

<b>Visa</b>	£610	Earliest: 3 Months before your start date. Latest: 6 Weeks before your start date
<b>Healthcare Surcharge</b>	£1200.00	When doing the Visa application
<b>Flight</b>	R12 000	Once your Visa has been approved
